The 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting / 2019 (Ordinary) of the FPCCI Executive Committee was held on 09-04-2019 at 11:00 a.m. at FPCCI Head Office, Karachi (Chair), FPCCI Capital Office Islamabad & FPCCI Regional Office Lahore, through Video Link under the Chairmanship of Engr. Daroo Khan Achakzai, President, FPCCI.

The list of the members attended the meeting is enclosed at Annex-I.

Due to lack of quorum, the Chair adjourned the meeting for half an hour. The members re-assembled at 11:30 a.m. Dr. Iqbal Thaheem, Secretary General declared that the quorum of the meeting was in order therefore, the meeting started with the recitation from the Holy Quran by Mr. Muslim Mohamedi, VP.

As proposed by the President, the House agreed to discuss this agenda item at the end i.e., completion of agenda item # 5.

**Agenda Item No.2: To confirm the minutes of the Meeting No.5 / 2018 of the Executive Committee of FPCCI held on 29<sup>th</sup> December 2018, at FPCCI Head Office Karachi and to review progress on the implementation of the decisions.**

The Chair Engr. Daroo Khan Achakzai invited comments from the house.

There being no comments, Mr. Arshad Jamal, VP proposed to confirm the minutes and approve the implementation reports which were seconded by Dr. Mirza Ikhtiar Baig, SVP.

Thereafter, it was;

RESOLVED THAT THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING NO.5 / 2018 OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF FPCCI HELD ON 29<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER 2018, AT FPCCI HEAD OFFICE KARACHI BE AND ARE HEREBY CONFIRMED.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE PROGRESS REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECISIONS OF EC MEETING NO.5 / 2018 HELD ON 29-12-2018 AT FPCCI HEAD OFFICE KARACHI BE AND ARE HEREBY APPROVED.

**Agenda Item No. 3: To confirm the minutes of the Meeting No.1 / 2019 of the Executive Committee of FPCCI held on 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2018, at FPCCI Head Office Karachi and to review progress on the implementation of the decisions.**

There being no comments, Mr. Muslim Mohamedi, VP and Mr. Arshad Jamal, VP proposed and seconded respectively, the minutes and the implementation reports of the EC Meeting No.1 / 2019 held on 29-12-2018 at FPCCI Head Office Karachi.

Thereafter, it was;

RESOLVED THAT THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING NO.1 / 2019 OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF FPCCI HELD ON 29<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2018, AT FPCCI HEAD OFFICE KARACHI BE AND ARE HEREBY CONFIRMED.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE PROGRESS REPORTS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION REPORTS OF THE DECISIONS OF THE EC MEETING NO.1/2019 HELD ON 29-12-2018 AT FPCCI HEAD OFFICE KARACHI BE AND ARE HEREBY APPROVED.

**Agenda Item No. 4: To review and adopt the Annual Accounts of FPCCI as audited by the external auditors for the year ended December 31, 2018.**

Dr. Mirza Ikhtiar Baig, SVP proposed that the FPCCI liabilities such as Sindh Board of Revenue dues etc., should be settled on priority basis.

Mr. Arshad Jamal, VP proposed to adopt the Annual Accounts which was seconded by Dr. Mirza Ikhtiar Baig, SVP.

The House also unanimously agreed.

Thereafter, it was;

RESOLVED THAT ANNUAL ACCOUNTS OF FPCCI AS AUDITED BY THE EXTERNAL AUDITORS FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2018 BE AND ARE HEREBY ADOPTED.

**Agenda Item No. 5: To recommend appointment of auditors for the year 2019 and fix their remuneration.**

On a query from the House, the Chair replied that M/s Naveed Zafar Ashfaq Jaffery & Co vide their letter dated April 1, 2019 had shown their consent to act as FPCCI auditor for the year ending December 31, 2019 on the same remuneration.

A member from Islamabad proposed to appoint M/s Naveed Zafar Ashfaq Jaffery & Co as Auditor of the FPCCI. The house also unanimously agreed.

However, the house observed that M/s Naveed Zafar Ashfaq Jaffery & Co has conducted Audit of Accounts of FPCCI for the last 3 years in a row. Hence they passed a special resolution to appoint M/s Naveed Zafar Ashfaq Jaffery & Co for conducting FPCCI Audit for the 4<sup>th</sup> consecutive year.

Thereafter, it was;

RESOLVED THAT M/S NAVEED ZAFAR ASHFAQ JAFFERY & CO BE AND ARE APPOINTED AUDITOR FOR THE YEAR 2019 ON THE SAME REMUNERATION.

Thereafter, the Chair took-up the Agenda Item # 1 as follows:

**Agenda Item No. 1: Welcome address and presentation of progress report of FPCCI for the last three months i.e., January – March 2019 by the President**

The Chair Engr. Daroo Khan Achakzai said, “He, as the FPCCI President, had been trying his level best to serve the business community of Pakistan indiscriminately and espousing their cause effectively. In this respect, he recalled that he had held meetings with concerned high-ups at the helm of affairs such as Mr. Saleem Mandviwala, Deputy Chairman Senate ; Raja Perwaiz Ashraf, Former Prime Minister of Pakistan ; Senator Imam Uddin etc. A FPCCI delegation under the leadership of its VP, Mr. Muhammad Ejaz Abbasi held a meeting with the Chairman NAB and discussed the problems of the business community”.

The Chamber Chief added that Mr. Asad Umar, Federal Finance Minister visited Federation House Karachi and Zonal Office Lahore and discussed the matter of mutual interest particularly related to Ease of Doing Business, higher tax rates ; development of industrial infrastructure, border trade, promotion of SMEs, EPZ, Special Economic Zones and Pre-Budget proposals. He went on to say that a FPCCI delegation led by him held a meeting with COAS General Qamar Javed Bajwa ; Corp Commander and D.G. Rangers. A Naval War College delegation consisting of 112 members also visited Federation House Karachi to get awareness about the FPCCI workings and its activities. FPCCI also issued a press release lamenting increase in SBP discount rate as it would be detrimental to industrial growth, appreciated government’s decision to open Torkham Border and urged the government to provide the same facilities to Chaman Border and other Borders so that the cross-border trade with the neighboring countries is facilitated and promoted and for this purpose proposed the government to prepare a Pak-Afghan and Pak-Iran trade policy to enhance bilateral trade ; Held a Joint Press Conference with ABAD urging the government to take care in abolishing legally constructed building. FPCCI in a press release urged the government to abolish GIDC as it was levied in past for development of infrastructure of gas pipe line from Turkmenistan; Held a Press Conference on Economic Reform Package and Mini-budget, wherein,

appreciating the positive measures, some harsh and irritant measures were lamented and suggestions for their improvement was given to improve the impact on national economy, FPCCI delegation visited Gwadar Free Zone and held meeting with the Chairman of China Overseas Ports Holding Company Ltd on matters of mutual interest particularly related to Pak-China trade and investment; Organized an I.T Conference in collaboration of foreign I.T Companies which was attended by Mr. Khalid Maqbool, Federal IT Minister as Special Guest. A delegation of Houston Karachi Sister City visited FPCCI Head Office for the promotion of trade between the two cities through exchange of trade and cultural delegations. FPCCI signed an MOU with Noble Sustainability Trust, Zurich with the view to promote research, invention and innovation culture; Held meetings with Ambassadors of Germany, Sri-Lanka and China for the promotion of bilateral trade.

Engr. Daroo Khan Achakzai, President said that an Audit and Finance Committee of FPCCI was formulated with the view to improve financial health of FPCCI and keep transparency in financial matters which has been working satisfactorily. All the Office Bearers – on the basis of their experience and field of interest – have been allocated Standing Committees ; Business Councils ; Departments etc. In addition to it, about 150 Standing Committees have been formulated and their Conveners and Deputy Conveners are being nominated on the basis of the recommendation of their trade bodies.

The President apprising the house of the second month (February-2019) of his tenure said, “Ms. Shireen Arshad Khan, VP held a meeting with DG, TDAP and discussed proposals for the promotion of Women Entrepreneurship, TEXPO etc. A joint Seminar in collaboration with Sindh Food Authority and All Pakistan Restaurants Association was held on Food Safety. FPCCI organized an international Maritime and Seaboard Asia Exhibition and Conference in Collaboration with E-Commerce Gateway, for the promotion of Maritime industry which was also attended by the Former Commander Pakistan Fleet, Rear Admiral Arifullah Husaini. Ambassadors of Poland, Afghanistan and Malaysia visited FPCCI for enhancement of bilateral trade. Participated in Pak-Saudi Business Forum and also held a press conference. A high powered Chinese delegation visited FPCCI. A FPCCI delegation under the leadership of Mr. S.M. Muneer visited KSEW wherein the delegation was briefed about the KSEW activities. A FPCCI delegation held meetings with Mr. Arif Alvi, President of Pakistan, Mr. Abdul Razzak Dawood, Commerce Minister and other ministers in Islamabad and briefed them about the problems and issues being confronted by the trade and industry. The then Finance Minister Mr. Asad Umar and FBR was repeatedly urged for the payment of long outstanding refund claims to exporters. FPCCI also linked a MOU with Houston Karachi Sister Association for promotion of trade and investment and exchange of cultural troops.

A 22-member Singaporean delegation visited FPCCI to explore the prospects of business collaboration. The occasion was also availed to arrange B-2-B meetings between Pakistan and Singapore through Business Network Connection and signed a MOU. The Federal Minister for Maritime, Mr. Ali Zaidi attended the event as Special Guest. A FPCCI delegation led by the FPCCI President inaugurated a Textile Machinery Exhibition in Karachi which was participated by 37 countries. The FPCCI President participated in 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Jeddah CCI during which he also held meeting with S.G Jeddah CCI and prominent businessmen.

Thereafter, the President Engr, Daroo Khan apprised the house of activities of FPCCI undertaken in March, 2019 as follows.

FPCCI organized an event “JAAG RAHA HAI PAKISTAN” to express solidarity with the armed forces which was also telephonically addressed by Dr. Adbul Qadir Khan. The President issued press releases on high electricity tariff rates ; interest rate and POL products prices. Also issued a press release lamenting misuse of discretionary powers of tax official and raid on business premises without prior notice. Thereafter, in response to FPCCI invitation, the then Chairman FBR Dr. Jehanzaib visited FPCCI and

extended the deadline of filing of Income Tax Returns (ITR), suspended raid on any premises of taxpayers, FBR's focal person was nominated to coordinate with FPCCI, etc. FPCCI in collaboration with BOI, Chinese Embassy and China for Promotion of South Cooperation Organized a Pak-China Investment and Trade Forum at Islamabad for transfer of Chinese technology to Pakistan and enhance exports from Pakistan to China. Held a consultative session through video link and formulated recommendations for the new proposed Amnesty Scheme. A delegation of Foreign Academy and National Institute of Management Quetta made Study Tour of FPCCI Head Office Karachi and got awareness about the FPCCI activities. FPCCI attended Islamic Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture's Board of Directors meeting and Annual meeting at Egypt wherein it was decided that next Board of Directors meeting would be held at Karachi in October 2019 and on the sideline, an OIC Investment Conference and an Exhibition would also be held. FPCCI prepared a report on Pak-Vietnam Economic and Commercial Relation. FPCCI delegation held a meeting with the Chinese Consul General at Karachi wherein, inter-alia, he (CG) was urged to restart issuing visa from Karachi. FPCCI inked an MOU with the CCPIT Sub-Council to promote trade activities between both the countries. FPCCI also signed an agreement with Turkmenistan CCI for the promotion of trade and investment activities between both the countries and constitution of Pak-Turkmenistan Business Council. During the visit of Malaysian Prime Minister Mr. Mohatir Muhammad to Pakistan, the FPCCI appreciated the proposal for enhancement of investment and held B2B meetings with the Malaysian counterparts.

**Agenda Item No. 6: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.**

The Chair taking this agenda informed that the FPCCI Budget Advisory Council under the Convenership of Mr. Zubair F. Tufail after an indepth consultation with its members consisting of representatives of trade bodies across the country, tax experts etc., prepared FPCCI Proposals for the Federal Budget 2019-20 on the basis of proposals / feedback received from our member trade bodies. He added that the Summary of the proposals have been forwarded to the EC members as working paper alongwith the EC Meeting Notice and is also placed in the meeting for discussion in the meeting.

Mr. Shahid proposed to remove the RD on tyre due to its smuggling.

In response to a query from Mr. Shahid, Mr. Zubair Tufail replied that the proposal on removal of RD on tyre has been included in the FPCCI Proposals.

Mr. Arshad Jamal VP said that the work / achievements of Associations should also be highlighted / discussed in the EC Meeting as an agenda item. In this respect he gave example of visit of DG Valuation to FPCCI. He further informed, "I have organized several meetings at FPCCI like visit of Director General Intellectual Property Rights through video conference in which the department gave awareness to trade ; meeting with Director General Valuation which was a great session ; as Vice President I along with Standing Committee of FPCCI and Office Bearers of APCA had a meeting with Chief Collector Appraisal South and Collector of Customs West and resolved a big issue of trade regarding submission of FTA certificates and trade benefited due to reduction in heavy cost of doing business. He added, "The concerned committees and departments do not take the Vice Presidents on board and still the distribution of work and assignments to VPs are pending and we can't perform our duties". He therefore, suggested that immediately the distribution of work may be reviewed with consultation of all Office Bearers and give them chance to perform their duties for the betterment of trade and industry. He also proposed that the associations / chambers should be allowed to purchase the Membership Certificate Book from FPCCI only to avoid fake membership.

In response to Mr. Arshad Jamal's proposal, Mr. Zubair Tufail, Convener of the FPCCI Budget Advisory Council agreed to include the names of all VPs in the list of FPCCI Advisory Council on Federal Budget 2019-20.

Syed Mazhar Ali Nasir informed the house that as urged by the FPCCI, the FBR has issued a notification for waiver of penal surcharge on goods over-stayed in warehouses.

Mr. Shaheen Ilyas Sarwana appreciated the efforts made by FPCCI Advisory Council on Federal Budget and the FPCCI Secretariat under the Convenership of Mr. Zubair Tufail in preparation of pragmatic Pre-Budget Proposals 2019-20.

A member underscored the need to undertake research on cotton seed and proposed that the import of good quality cotton seed be encouraged.

A representative from Pakistan Vanaspati Manufacturers Association proposed that duty on import of all oil-seed be levied so that its cultivation in the country is encouraged.

A representative of Industrial gloves manufacturer (Sialkot) proposed that duty free Split Leather import be allowed to facilitate re-export of industrial gloves as it is an industrial raw material and is subject to import duty @ 3-5%. He also suggested for a uniform policy both for commercial and industrial importers of raw material.

Shaikh Gulzar proposed to reduce the Sales Tax rate to single digit and that the import of goods, manufactured locally, be restricted.

Perwaiz Anwar Shaikh from Lahore proposed that the assesseees under full and final tax regime should not be included in audit list. He lamented that Sales Tax Refunds have not been paid for the last six years.

The Chair asked the representative of CNG Association to send his suggestion on reduction of advance tax from 4% to 1% in writing supported by fact and figures, to FPCCI for inclusion in the FPCCI Pre-Budget Proposals.

The President Engr. Daroo Khan Achakzai proposed that warehouses should be established at Pakistani Border with neighboring countries to facilitate export via land route.

Mr. Naqi Bari said that refund of Duty Drawback and Local Taxes and Levies (DLTL) have been lying pending since 2019. He proposed to do away with the EDF and allowing Export Refinance subsidy to exporters.

Mr. Zubair F. Tufail, Convener of the Budget Advisory Council asked Mr. Naqi Bari to send the proposal in writing to FPCCI.

A representative from Sahiwal proposed that industry be given priority as no agriculture country has made development on the basis of agricultural production. He also proposed to increase data base on the basis of NADRA's data on affluent and wealthy people.

Senator Haseeb Khan wanted that FPCCI in its Pre-Budget Proposals should talk on key salient features. He stressed the need to enhance allocation of fund for education at least 5% of GDP as without equipping our manpower with education, the dream of development would not come true. He proposed that corruption be dealt with iron hand ; direct taxes should be 65% of total tax cache ; wherever the income is generated be taxed without discrimination ; No Amnesty Scheme as it is issued at the Cost of honest taxpayer ; Exports of Halal Food, fruits and vegetable be promoted ; SMEs be facilitated ; instead of raw marble , value added goods of marble be encouraged ; CPEC is like a tool and we should use it to get

benefit without hurting our indigenous industry, Tax defaulters and corrupt people should not go scotch free ; The goods produced locally should not be allowed to import to protect local industry.

In response to the proposal regarding removal of advance tax on advertisement, the President asked the representative to send his proposal in writing.

In response to the proposals given by Mr. Muslim Mohamedi, VP for development of fisheries sector , the Chair informed him that his suggestions have been incorporated in the FPCCI Pre-Budget Proposals.

The President urged the government, “Being an apex body of trade and industry, the FPCCI should be given representation on all the Economic Committees, Advisory Boards etc., related to economy”.

The house unanimously agreed.

A representative of Pakistan Yarn Merchants Association wanted that only surplus yarn should be allowed to export to encourage export of value added industry. He also invited attention of the house towards the dilapidated condition of yarn manufacturing industry in Faisalabad mainly due to high cost of production.

The President asked him to send the proposals in writing.

A representative of Karachi Cotton Association informed that even after completion of all the formalities, the DGTO did not issue license.

Thereafter, the following resolution was placed by the President in the meeting which was unanimously resolved.

“IT IS UNFORTUNATE THAT THE FPCCI, AN APEX TRADE BODY OF PAKISTAN, IS SOMEHOW BEING IGNORED BY CERTAIN ELEMENTS IN THE GOVERNMENT. IT HAS BEEN NOTICED THAT BUSINESS FORUMS AND ORGANIZATIONS – NOT REGISTERED / NOT RECOGNIZED BY THE DGTO – ARE PREFERRED IN NOMINATIONS IN THE IMPORTANT ECONOMIC ADVISORY AND CONSULTATIVE BODIES CONSTITUTED BY THE GOVERNMENT. SIMILARLY, THE NOMINATIONS OF FPCCI ON IMPORTANT BOARDS OF DIRECTORS OF VARIOUS ORGANIZATIONS ARE MISSING.

FPCCI IS AFFILIATED WITH ALL IMPORTANT CHAMBERS OF THE WORLD AND OPERATES WITH JOINT BUSINESS COUNCILS OF ABOUT 100 COUNTRIES, THEREFORE HAS STRONG SENSE OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESSES AND THEIR TREND AND REQUIREMENTS. FPCCI’S REPRESENTATIVE CAN EFFECTIVELY GUIDE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO ENHANCE EXPORT.

FPCCI THEREFORE, REQUESTS THAT ITS NOMINATION / NOMINTEE MAY ALSO BE APPOINTED ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ALL THE IMPORTANT ECONOMIC ADVISORY AND CONSULTATIVE BODIES OF THE GOVERNMENT.

ALSO RESOLVED THAT THE FPCCI PROPOSALS FOR THE FEDERAL BUDGET 2019-20 BE AND ARE HEREBY APPROVED.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE SERVICES RENDERED BY ENGR. DAROO KHAN ACHAKZAI, PRESIDENT AND MR. ZUBAIR F. TUFAIL, CONVENER AND ALL THE MEMBERS

OF FPCCI BUDGET ADVISORY COUNCIL IN PREPARATION OF FPCCI PRE-BUDGET PROPOSALS BE AND ARE HEREBY APPRECIATED.

There being no other agenda items to discuss, the meeting was terminated with the vote of thanks to the Chair.
